#### Course content/description

The PSHE/Citizenship department draws on guidance issued by the Department for Education for Personal Social, Health, Economic Education, as well as on the statutory National Curriculum guidance for Sex and Relationship Education. Programmes of learning reflect a 'spiral' curriculum, building on previous experience and knowledge, revisiting themes in an age-appropriate way.

In year 7 the following themes are covered: - Group-building, Communication, Friendship, Bullying, aspects of Drugs Education, Human Rights, Diversity, Stereotyping, Healthy Lifestyle

#### Assessment

Pupils complete self-assessment of knowledge, attitudes and skills at regular intervals on units of work.

Teacher assessment of key interactive and oral skills is carried out at termly.

#### Books/other/materials/visits

A wide variety of resources are used, including those suggested by the National PSHE Association, and other respected organisations (such as NSPCC, Red Cross, FPA, etc)

Use of visitors such as the School Nurse, Community Liaison Police Officer.
